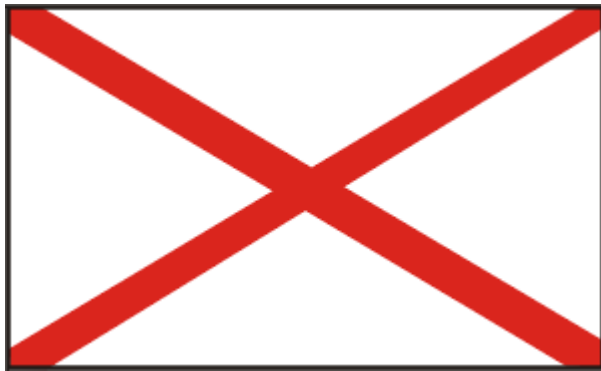
- Llanfairpwllgwyngyllgogerychwyrndrobwllllantysiliogogogoch is a town in Wales, the longest name of any place in the world.
